PRICE CONTROL & ENFORCEMENT BY NATIONAL PHARMACEUTICAL PRICING AUTHORITY (NPPA) FOR BENEFIT OF CONSUMERS.

Affordable medicine for all

• NPPA notified prices of 883 formulations upto December 2015 covering cancer, Diabetes, HIV- AIDS etc (436 formulations since May 2014):

- Ceiling prices of Scheduled formulations notified totaling 530 upto December 2015 (137 since May 2014)
- MRP of non –Scheduled formulations notified totaling 106 since July 2014, to date.

• "Pharma Jan Samadhan" – an effective complaint redressal system for availability and prices of medicines, put in place.

• Pharma Price Data Bank launched on 25.06.2015 as an Integrated Pharmaceutical Database Management System (IPDMS).



POLICY INITIATIVES

Cluster Development scheme

A scheme to establish common facilities which will reduce fixed cost by 30% of a manufacturing plant thus making small and medium enterprise competitive.

Task Force for growth of Pharma sector

Task force chaired by Secretary, department of Pharmaceuticals has drown a roadmap of action by various Government Department/Agencies for promoting Pharma sector.

Medical Devices to be promoted

Government has liberalised FDI policy in the process of correction of inverted duty structure, promoting preferential market access policy and facilitating setting up of medical devices park for promoting this sector.

Promotion of Bulk Drugs in the Country

Various recommendations/ intervetions suggested by the committee headed by Dr. V. M. Kotoch including setting up of dedicated bulk drug Parks are actively being pursued.
