
Department of Pharmaceuticals has notified the Guidelines for the Scheme “Strengthening of Pharmaceuticals Industry” (SPI) vide Notification No. G-30015/25/2021-Scheme dated 11.03.2022. Pursuant to the deliberations held with the Industry representatives and on examination of the representations received in this regard, modifications are done in few clauses of the Guidelines and accordingly, same are notified as below:

There shall be a minimum of 5 pharma units as members of (SPV).</p> <p>The SPV should be a separate legal entity registered under the Companies Act or Registration of Societies Act.</p>	<p>Note: If the existing cluster is already registered under the Companies Act, same will be considered for further processing. No need to form separate cluster.</p>
