Subject: Invitation of bid for Evaluation Study of Working of 'Creation of IPR Facilitation Centre' scheme during the XI Five Year Plan Period.

Sir,

I am directed to refer on the above subject and to say that the Department of Pharmaceuticals, Ministry of Chemicals and Fertilizers invites quotations as per details given below from all the agencies included in the list of reputed research institution empanelled by the Planning Commission for outsourcing evaluation studies.

Background: The Working Group on Drugs and Pharmaceuticals for the 11th Five Year Plan (2007-12) had recommended Rs. 5 crore for the scheme - titled "Creation of IPR Facilitation Center". However, Rs. 3.56 crores was allocated. The main objectives of the scheme are:

- To equip the Pharma Industries to effectively use IP as part of their business strategy;
- To interface with the Government of India to develop strategies, policies and programs to meet the intellectual property needs of Pharma Industries;
- To provide value added IP-related services to Pharma Industries;
- Provide comprehensive web-based information and basic advice on IP issues to Pharma Industries support organizations worldwide;
- Strengthening of interaction between Pharma Industry, support institutions and associations and IP offices, and other relevant government organization with a view to better identifying the needs of Pharma Industry and facilitating the implementation of customized targeted activities addressing the specific IP needs of each sector, group or cluster;
- Support of national and international efforts for further integration of IP issues in programs and policy initiative aiming at fostering the technological and innovative capacity and the export potential of Pharma Industry;
- Increase awareness and understanding of IP issues within the Pharma business community particularly through awareness raising campaigns and targeted training programs with the optimal use of modern information and communication technologies, so as to enhance the capacity of Pharma Industry to maximize their benefits from the use of the IP systems;

- Advice government to take into account the specific needs of Pharma Industry in their IP policies;
- Disseminate information on best practices on the use of IP by Pharma Industry and of their exploitation of technological knowledge through the valorization and commercialization of IP rights;
- Make a access to technological knowledge easier and cheaper for Pharma Industry.

2. Out of Rs. 3.56 crores allocated for this Scheme during the 11th Plan Period the actual expenditure was as under:

3. **Progress of the Scheme:**

The activities executed by Patent Facilitation Center at Pharmexcil are as under:

- (i) **Patent Awareness Programs:** Even though patent system existed in India since 1970s in the form of process patents, awareness to public was only since post GATT era (1995). There is a necessity to bring awareness relating to intellectual property and patent facilitation center at Pharmexcil had organized several awareness programmes throughout the country. However, there is a necessity to update information relating to higher end case studies, infringement analysis, filing procedures, compulsory licensing etc. There is still a necessity among professionals is providing basics relating to intellectual property rights.
- (ii) **Patent Search:** Prior art play a key role in innovations that are patentable. There is a necessity to compile all the patents existing for a particular invention so that patentability can be achieved with novelty, non-obviousness and useful. There is a necessity of providing to the industry online paid databases where the industry personnel wishes to do their individual search. Such provision helps the industry in avoiding initial investment for such databases and divert for development of products.
- (iii) **Patent awards:** As an encouragement to the industry, Pharmexcil has declared Patent Awards for the third consecutive year. Patent awards under the category of Platinum, Gold, Silver, Certificate of Appreciation were conferred to the members for the last three financial years. Granting a company with a patent for an invention by a patent office is a cumbersome process involving investment in terms of man power, time, research and development. The time span for a patentable invention may be considered on an average of at least 2-5 years. Such innovations require encouragement not only in terms of awards but also some financial re-imbursement from the government (list of awardees during last three years enclosed).
- (iv) **Infringement analysis/Freedom to Operate:** Developing and exporting a pharmaceutical product to various countries involves thorough prior art search along with patents existing in a particular country. A thorough study of the technology involved in the

patents helps in identifying non-infringing methods and suggest the industry to develop products for exports under freedom to operate grounds.

(v) **Important Circulars released:** In addition to regular activities, members of Pharmexcil were circulated relating to information that is technologically useful for the development of pharmaceutical products. The following information was circulated to members of Pharmexcil:

a. **Pharma Product Patent Expiry:** Pharma product patents hinder the Indian pharmaceutical industry in exporting products. As a forecast, Pharmexcil has released information as a relating pharma product patents – expiring during 2011 to 2030. This forecast information is very crucial to the industry so that products can be released at the right time soon after the patent expiry.

b. **USFDA Approved Products Patent Expiry:** USFDA provides a detailed list of approved drug products that can be marketed in USA. Patent expiry for the corresponding products may hinder export of Indian products into US.

c. **USFDA Approved Products Market Exclusivity Expiry:** USFDA provides a detailed list of approved drug products that can be marketed in USA. Market exclusivity expiry for the corresponding products help in planning research and overcome saving time relating to development of product, non-clinical and clinical study, drug approval process and release into the market.

d. **USFDA Approved Inactive ingredients:** Inactive ingredients such as diluents, excipients, colourants, disintegrating agents, polymers, solvents, suspending agents, deflocculating agents etc are used in the development of formulations. USFDA has approved 3017 inactive ingredients in 11100 specific routes of administration and dosages forms. Such information is circulated to the members so as to help the formulation industries that are not aware of such data so that formulation design becomes easier by saving time, money and approval process.

(vi) **Special provision to small pharmaceutical industries:**

Small pharmaceutical industries are believed to be crucial in economical growth as well as employment. Even though several provisions are available to such industries, they are in need of new product development to increase their exports. Several industries are stagnant in terms of research leading to innovations and protecting in terms of patents. Pharmexcil believes in providing awareness relating to regulatory, intellectual property, export protocols etc. who are members.

4. **Terms of Reference:**

- (i) Preparation of evaluation benchmarks of progress and performance of the scheme.
- (ii) To assess the extent to which the scheme has fulfilled its objective(s).
- (iii) To assess the success rate of implementation with the objective for the further extension of scheme during the 12th Five Year Plan.
- (iv) Phasing of expenditure in the 12th Five Year Plan under the scheme.
- (v) Any additional parameters to be covered which may emerge during discussion/interaction in the course of above work.

5. **Duration of Consultancy:**

The duration of the completion of the evaluation study is three months from the date of commencement of the assignment. The draft report should be submitted by the end of the two months. After receiving the final draft report from the Govt., the Agency should submit the final report within one month from the date of its approval.

6. **Eligibility Norms:**

Proposals are invited for appointment of an agency for carrying out work as per the TOR stated above. The Agency:

1. Should have been empanelled by the Planning Commission for carrying out the evaluation of Plan Schemes,
2. Should have experience in completion of similar nature of assignment,
3. Should have completed similar study/report for any Government Organisation (Central or State) or Planning Commission during the last five years,
4. Should have professionals with experience in Pharma sector, project management, evaluation of projects, etc.
5. Should be capable of deputing at least one well-qualified personnel heading the team for the above assignment having relevant experience preferably in pharmaceutical sector/manufacturing industry.

7. **Selection Process and Evaluation Criteria:**

(a) Selection Process

The agency shall be selected through a Limited Competitive Bidding process from agencies empanelled by the Planning Commission for evaluation studies. The bidding process shall be carried out in two stages i.e. Technical Bid & Financial Bid.

(i) Technical Proposals:

The technical proposal must elucidate the experience of the firm relevant to the present assignment. It should describe in a precise and concise manner the approach and methodology for the execution of the assignment. The technical proposal must also contain detailed Curriculum Vitae of Experts who will be involved in the conduct of the assignment covering the relevant areas of expertise such as project management, evaluation, impact assessment, data analysis, etc. The above team is to be supported by surveyors for data collection and other support staff as necessary. The technical proposal must not have any financial information, whatsoever.

(ii) Financial Proposal:

The financial proposal should give details about the consultation charges. The consultants must hold their proposals valid for 90 days from the date of submission of the proposal.

(b) Evaluation Criteria:

The evaluation of the proposals will involve a two steps procedure. The technical bids will be evaluated first on the following criteria:

For qualifying, the firm needs to score a minimum of 70 % marks in the technical evaluation.

Financial bids of only the technically qualified firms will be opened on a designated date in the presence of technically qualified bidders. The financial bids of the unqualified bidders will be kept sealed.

► The firm achieving the highest combined technical and financial scores would be awarded the assignment.

(c) In the event of a tie in the final combined scores, the consultants having the lower financial quote amongst the two would be given preference and would be invited for negotiation.

8. **Documents required with proposal:**

Eligible agency willing to take up above work may submit proposal along with following documents:

- (a) Year of establishment of Organisation/agency.
- (b) Turnover of organisation in consultancy work for the last 3 years (2009-10, 2010-11 & 2011-12) should be at least 30% of the estimated cost.
- (c) Experience of having successfully completed similar work during last 5 years ending last day of month previous to the one in which applications are invited.
- (d) Number of professionals proposed for the work, with their qualification and experience of each in completing similar type of schemes.
- (e) A brief note on methodology of work and time schedule is to be enclosed along with the offer.
- (f) Amount quoted to conduct study should be inclusive of all applicable taxes.
- (g) Key Contact person (Name and Contact details).

9. **Terms of Payments:**

The terms of payment for each assignment under this Scheme will be as under:

- (i) The selected Agency will sign an Agreement with the Ministry of Chemicals and Fertilizers, Department of Pharmaceuticals, Government of India, New Delhi for rendering the services.
- (ii) **First installment:** 40 per cent of the fees on signing of the agreement shall be made against Bank Guarantee of equivalent amount from a Scheduled Bank in favour of Government of India till receipt of draft report from the successful bidder and acceptable to the Government.
- (iii) **Second installment:** 35 per cent, subject to (a) submission of the draft report (5 copies of the draft report including executive summary) within the time frame stipulated in the agreement and (b) a presentation on the draft report being made before the Steering Committee at New Delhi and the draft report being found to be generally acceptable.
- (iv) **Third and final installment:** balance 25 per cent on submission of the final report and its acceptance by the Government. Any delay in submission of report

without due approval by the Ministry will attract a penalty of 5% per week and the balance 25% will be forfeited on delay in submission of the report beyond 5 weeks from the stipulated date. The final payment will be made within 6 weeks on acceptance of the report and submission of bills etc. by the agency.

10. **General Terms & Conditions:**

The other general terms and conditions applicable to assignment under this Scheme will be:

- (i) The assignment should be completed within the time stipulated in the agreement. Delay in submission of the report beyond the stipulated time will attract penalty as provided for in the agreement. For factors beyond the control of the Institution given the assignment, suitable extension in time may, however, be granted at the request of the Institution.
- (ii) The Government shall not pay any extra amount for any escalation in the cost of the assignment beyond the time period stipulated in the agreement.
- (iii) The total fee for the study as agreed with the organization will include service tax and other tax, if any, and the liability of payment of the tax will be of the Institution conducting the study.
- (iv) 10 hard copies of the final report, 15 hard copies of the executive summary and 50 CDs containing the final report shall be submitted before releasing the final installment of payment.
- (v) During the course of the assignment, Government may modify the TOR and other terms and conditions of the assignment, if necessary, in order to strengthen/deepen its scope/coverage. As far as possible, such modifications will not be made more than once during course of study and with the due concurrence of the Institution concerned. In case, there is cost escalation due to substantial and major changes in the Terms of Reference, such cost escalation shall be restricted to a maximum of 25% over and above the original cost subject to the approval of Integrated Finance Wing.
- (vi) The draft/final reports and the contents thereof would be the intellectual property of the Government and would not be published by the Institution concerned without prior approval of the Government.
- (vii) In case of change of consultant/team leader during the course of study, the new consultant/team leader may be appointed by the Institution with the prior approval of the Ministry.
- (viii) The Consultant will notify the Government of any material change in their status, shareholding or that of any Guarantor of the Consultant, where such change would impact on performance of obligations of the Consultant under the Agreement.
- (ix) If the performance of the Institution during the course of the study is not found to be satisfactory, the agreement can be terminated and the amount already paid to the Institution will be recovered.
- (x) The raw data/ processed data/findings should not be disclosed by the Institution to any third party without prior approval of the Government.

(xi) Ministry of Chemicals and Fertilizers, Department of Pharmaceuticals, Government of India reserves the right to reject any proposal without assigning any reason thereof.

11. **Submission of Proposals:**
