1. Background :

Department of Pharmaceuticals was earlier a Division in Department of Chemicals & Petrochemicals (DCPC). DCPC had a scheme namely, Chemical Promotion and Development Scheme (CPDS) for promotion, development and export promotion in the sectors of Pharmaceutical, Chemical and Petrochemicals. When in July 2008 the Department of Pharmaceuticals was carved out of Department of Chemicals & Petrochemicals, funds for the promotion and development of Pharmaceuticals sector were separated under the Pharmaceuticals Promotion and Development Scheme (PPDS) from the year 2009-10 onwards.

2. Objective of the Scheme :

Pharmaceuticals Promotion & Development Scheme (PPDS) aims at the promotion, development and export promotion in the Pharma sector.

3. Scope of the Scheme :

Under this scheme, the following activities for promoting the industry are undertaken :

- i) Activities for the Pharma sector by promoting seminars, conferences, exhibitions, mounting delegations to and from India for promotion of exports as well as investments, conducting studies/ consultancies, for facilitating growth, exports as well as critical issues affecting Pharma sector.
- ii) All miscellaneous activities relating to promotion of Pharma sector for production, exports and investments.

Besides these, various other promotional activities such as conducting studies, purchase of important reports/ publications, pharmacopoeias are also undertaken under PPDS.

4. Budget Allocation :

7. Duration of Consultancy:

The duration of the completion of the evaluation study is three months from the date of commencement of the assignment. The draft report should be submitted by the end of the two months. 8. Eligibility Norms:

9. Selection Process AND Evaluation Criteria

The agency shall be selected through a Limited Competitive Bidding process from agencies empanelled by the Planning Commission for evaluation studies. The bidding process shall be carried out in two stages i.e. Technical Bid & Financial Bid.

(i) Technical Proposals:

The technical proposal must elucidate the experience of the firm relevant to the present assignment. It should describe in a precise and concise manner the approach and methodology for the execution of the assignment. The technical proposal must also contain detailed Curriculum Vitae of Experts who will be involved in the conduct of the assignment covering the relevant areas of expertise such as project management, evaluation, impact assessment, data analysis, etc. The above team is to be supported by surveyors for data collection and other support staff as necessary. The technical proposal must not have any financial information, whatsoever.

(ii) Financial Proposal:

The financial proposal should give details about the consultation charges. The consultants must hold their proposals valid for 90 days from the date of submission of the proposal.

(iii) Evaluation of Proposals and Evaluation Criteria:

The evaluation of the proposals will involve a two steps procedure. The technical bids will be evaluated first on the following criteria:

(iv) In the event of a tie in the final combined scores, the consultants having the lower financial quote amongst the two would be given preference.

10. Documents required with proposal :

Eligible agency willing to take up above work may submit proposal along with following documents :

11. Terms of Payments:

The terms of payment for each assignment under this Scheme will be as under:

- (i) The selected Agency will sign an Agreement with the Ministry of Chemicals and Fertilizers, Department of Pharmaceuticals, Government of India, New Delhi for rendering the services.
- (ii) First Installment: 40 percent of the fees on signing of the agreement shall be made against Bank Guarantee of equivalent amount from a Scheduled Bank in favour of Government of India till receipt of draft report from the successful bidder and acceptable to the Government.
- (iii) Second Installment: 35 percent, subject to (a) submission of the draft report (5copies of the draft report including executive summary) within the time frame stipulated in the agreement and (b) a presentation on the draft report being made before the Steering Committee at New Delhi and the draft report being found to be generally acceptable.
- (iv) Third and final Installment: balance 25 percent on submission of the final report and its acceptance by the Government. Any delay in submission of report without due approval by the Ministry will attract a penalty of 5% per week and the balance 25% will be forfeited on delay in submission of the report beyond 5 weeks from the stipulated date. The final payment will be made within 6 weeks on acceptance of the report and submission of bills etc. by the agency.

12. General Terms & Conditions:

The other general terms and conditions applicable to assignment under this Scheme will be:

- i) The assignment should be completed within the time stipulated in the agreement. Delay in submission of the report beyond the stipulated time will attract penalty as provided for in the agreement. For factors beyond the control of the institution given the assignment, suitable extension in time may, however, be granted at the request of the Institution.
- ii) The Government shall not pay any extra amount for any escalation in the cost of the assignment beyond the time period stipulated in the agreement.

- iii) The total fee for the study as agreed with the organization will include service tax and other tax, if any, and the liability of payment of the tax will be of the Institution conducting the study.
- iv) 10 hard copies of the final report, 15 hard copies of the executive summary and 50 CDs containing the final report shall be submitted before releasing the final installment of payment.
- v) During the course of the assignment, Government may modify the TOR and other terms and conditions of the assignment, if necessary, in order to strengthen/ deepen its scope/ coverage. As far as possible, such modifications will not be made more than once during course of study and with the due concurrence of the Institution concerned. In cane, there is cost escalation due to substantial and major changes in the Terms of Reference, such cost escalation shall be restricted to a maximum of 25% over and above the original cost subject to the approval of Integrated Finance Wing.
