The Secretary (Pharma) Chaired the Steering Committee Meeting and at the outset the Chairperson welcomed all the participants present.

### 2. Proceedings of the meeting agenda item wise are as follows:

21.1	The Steering Committee confirmed the Minutes of the Meeting of 20 <sup>th</sup> Steering
	Committee.
21.2	Approval of cost estimates of NIPER Guwahati for an amount of Rs 159.69 crore
	(duly vetted by third party i.e. IIT) for phase I of construction submitted by NIPER,
	Guwahati/ Engineers project India Ltd. (EPIL) was placed before the Steering
	Committee. The EPIL made a PPT. The Steering Committee approved the estimates.
	The PMC was requested to submit the cost estimates for all 3 phases within 15 days.
21.3	Approval of drawings/ layout of NIPER, Ahmedabad as submitted by NIPER,
	Ahmedabad/HSCL. Dr. Kiran Kalia, Director Ahmedabad presented the detailed
	layout drawings for various buildings (Academic, Administrative, Residential etc.).
	The total area proposed by NIPER Ahmedabad is about 36 thousand sq.mtrs as
	against 30 thousand sq.mtrs recommended in the DPR. Director Ahmedabad
	requested that the layout/drawing has been prepared keeping in view the essential
	requirements for smooth and efficient functioning of the NIPER. She informed that
	the requisite compliances of GLP norms has been taken care of and due consultation
	with NIPER Mohali has been done. Director NIPER requested the committee to
	approve the layout/drawings. Director NIPER Ahmedabad also informed that the
	tentative cost estimates for phase I construction of the campus will be about 175.00
	crores. The layout and design of NIPER Ahmedabad for Phase-I was approved by the
	Committee. The PMC was requested to submit the cost estimates for all 3 phases
	within 15 days.
21.4	Decision on constitution of selection committee for appointment of Directors in New
	NIPERs: Presently all the posts of Directors in the NIPERs are laying vacant except

	the post of Director NIPER, Ahmedabad. The Steering Committee constituted a
	committee of 4 experts under the chairmanship of Dr.V.Nagarajan, Chairperson of
	the last selection Committee of NIPER Directors.
21.5	Revision of fellowship/scholarship of Research Scholars of NIPERs (as per the guidelines of DST vide their OM no SR/S9/Z-09/2012 dated 21.10.2014) was discussed. The meeting resolved that the decision will be taken upon receipt of cost implications from all NIPERs, in the next steering committee with appropriate consideration of budgetary provision.
21.6	Steering committee approved the awarding of degrees to the students of NIPERs Hyderabad for batch 2012-14.
21.7	Tentative Budget for FY 2015-16. All NIPERs were requested to submit the estimates considering Civil works and capital (equipment's) expenditure, recurring expenditure including salaries of proposed recruitment of faculty.
