Trend Values of the success indicators

The Department of Pharmaceuticals was created with effect from 1.7.2008. As such, comparison with 2007-08 & 2008-09 may not be possible. The values of the success indicators would be determined with reference to the success in terms of completion of activity.

Description of definition of Success Indicators and proposed measurement methodology

The success indicators have been defined on the basis of appropriate measurable parameters such as for Time wherever applications for disposal are concerned or preparation of proposals for various schemes and projects and concerning approvals from concerned central Ministries is concerned. It is defined in values in Rs crores wherever funds expenditure is involved. Care has been taken so as each of the activities is measurable in respect of performance monitoring and evaluation.

Specific Performance requirements from other Departments

- 1. Receipt of timely approval from the Planning Commission and budgetary sanctions from the Ministry of Finance relating to the proposed schemes of the Department. Accordingly Planning Commission and Finance Department are expected to approve the proposed outlays and related budget for fulfillment of targets / project proposals as specified in objectives 2-11 failing which the RFD would be a paper exercise only.
- 2. SI-2 of Objective: As regards the performance of CPSUs, the Department in its periodic monthly reviews can guide the CPSUs towards achieving the targets. However actual target achievement would depend on the efforts of the MDs concerned.
- 3. As regards out of India initiatives in Objective 6, achievement of objective would depend on MEA
